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The Magic of Science is a show that demonstrates to children simple practical ideas in science that they can try for themselves.

The Magic of Science is a learning experience. The ideas shown are designed to encourage the development of a variety of skills, which can be followed up as a special project or slotted into the curriculum.

The aim of **The Magic of Science** show is to enable the children to see that science can be fun.

The show lasts about 45 - 50 minutes and is suitable for groups of about 150 children at a time. They will go away from the show wanting to try out all the ideas they will have seen.

No magic is performed in the show. However, Tony's knowledge of the entertainment business coupled with his experience in the education world enable him to provide an entertaining and educational presentation.
